What:

- Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation Annual Oyster Roast is partnering with Arts on the Coast again this year.
- They are looking for art that is lowcountry, coastal and/or Savannah in flavor (this is the crowd and what they feel would sell best)
- Artists can bring up to 4 pieces (depending on participation I will try and hang all 4 but space may be limited), no larger than 36" on any side. All pieces need to be ready to hang with wire, framed or finished edges, all pieces must also have a tag to display with price, title, size, medium and artist's name. If any piece does not meet all these criteria it WILL NOT be displayed
- Artists can also bring prints and other items (cards, tea towels, etc) for sale.
- Event is a fundraiser for the Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation and Arts on the Coast. For all sales the split will be 50% to the artist, 25% to CBTF and 25% to AOC. (Minus any Square service fees)
- All participating artists get all you can eat for the event.
- I encourage all artists participating to attend and get to speak with potential buyers and members of the community but you do not need to be attending to participate

How:

- Drop off for artwork will be Saturday the 2nd, 2pm-4pm at the Wetland Center (I will be there for intake) this is the day to bring prints and any other items as well
- There is an alternate drop off day and time if you can't make it Saturday. That is Thursday the 29th from 12-4pm at the Richmond Hill History Museum
- If an artist wants to be part of Facebook posts promoting the event please email me an image of your artwork, with title, size and price by Feb 23rd. I will be posting on Monday the 26th and sharing to community pages that day.
